### Considerations and points of focus during the more than 18 months of the COVID-19 pandemic

The CVMD-19 pandemic has continued for more than 18 months at this point, and there are two major conclusions that 1 have come to on the back of this. He first point being that, while the CVMD-19 pandemic may be prolonged to some astact, at some point it is sure to abata, and with that, the demand for karacke will return. And the second point is find that we must do all we can to maintain the eyestem and stem the Beleding in preparation for such as recovery.


